 - Currently \$3300 in checking account, \$15 in paypal, \$900 earmarked for Deuces for Deuces/Sisters improvements.

 - Suggestion to rotate between Saturdays and Sundays next year. Seems to be unlikely due to various factors such as winter league, football, etc.
 - Discussion regarding using random parks for winter events/COWS and setting up temporary courses.
 - It was a good pilot program for this year and we'll revisit later for the upcoming winter.
 - Disc order was a little much so will re-evaluate for next year.
 - Bag Tags- Mike Beshore
 - New sponsor- Gorilla Growlers. Coupon is printed on each tag and they also paid for the tags.
 - Various bag tag nights kicked off this past week. Rules and format are on the website
